

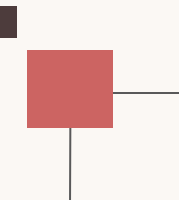

What's H5P?

- Authoring tools for creating interactive videos, presentations, drag/drop activities, virtual tours, and more.
- H5P is currently integrated into UVA Collab (A&S) and Canvas (EHD) by request, and is also available via WordPress & Drupal.

- Students work at their own pace
- Mastery of material
- Access:
 - Graded: through UVACollab
 - Ungraded: through UVACollab or on a Wordpress or Drupal site

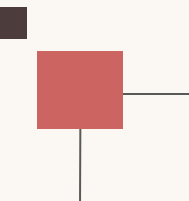
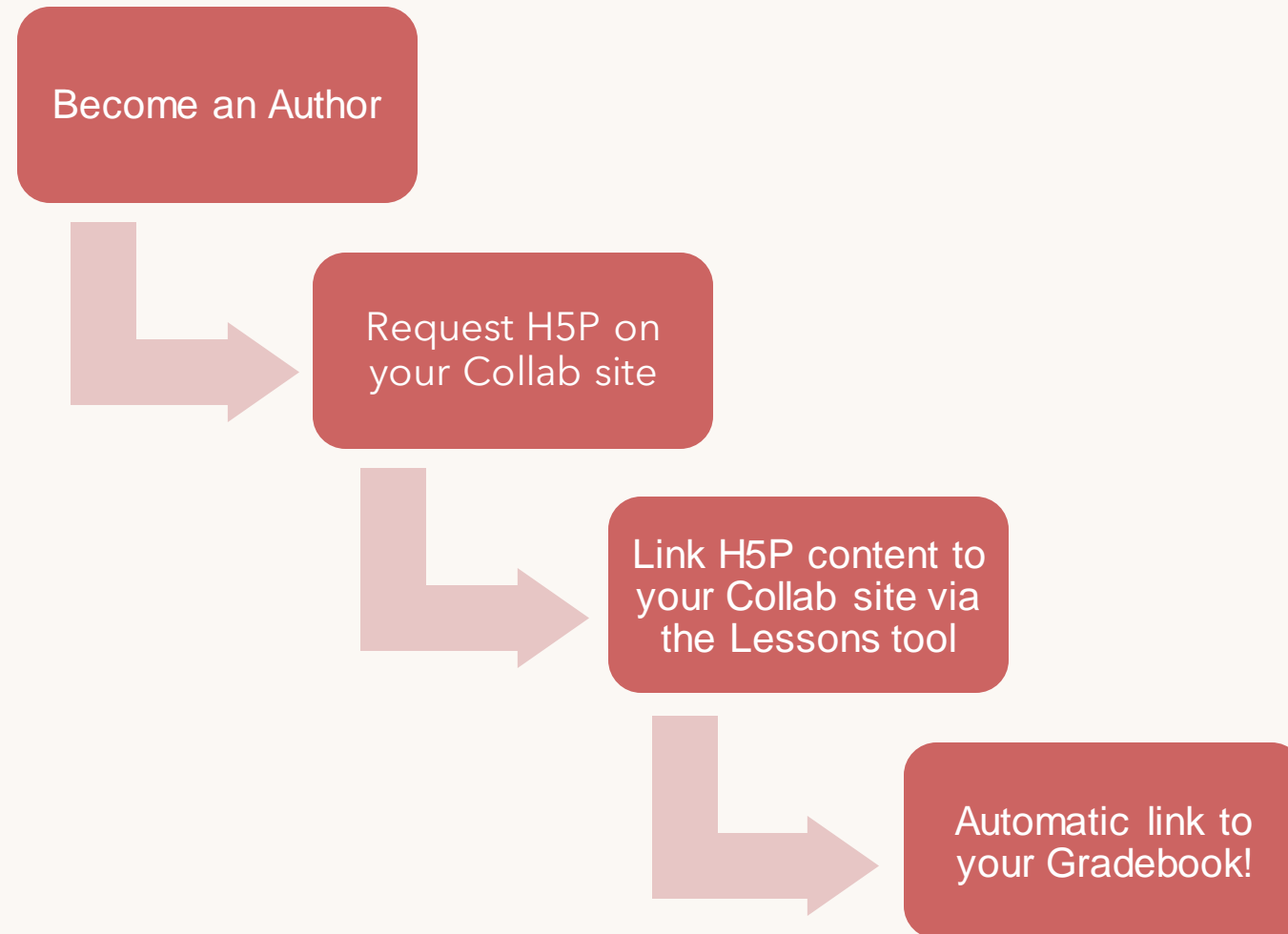


A note on Openness, Access, and H5P

- H5P maintains a transparent list of what is and isn't accessible
- Use of H5P content by students is free and possible via the LMS (Collab, Canvas)
- H5P's structure is designed to enable simple sharing, giving credit where credit is due



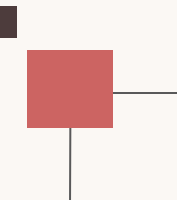
How it works in UVACollab

OER: Open Educational Resources



Creative Commons defines OER as teaching, learning, and research materials that are either (a) in the public domain or (b) licensed in a manner that provides everyone with free and perpetual permission to engage in the 5R activities—retaining, remixing, revising, reusing and redistributing the resources.
